In October of 2007, I became aware that food establishments throw perfectly good food in the garbage. It drove me nuts, and my family started picking up food at local restaurants in support of our local food pantries. To this day I am completely discontent with the idea that 40% of our food is wasted, while 1 in 6 are food insecure in America. Since that time, Food Rescue has connected over 200 caring agencies with over 200 restaurants, and 350 schools resulting in over a million meals being rescued annually.

We do not manage any of these connections, as our focus is advocacy, education, and initial logistics to get things started”.
